

# WLHS SUBSTANCE-FREE GRAD PARTY 2019

Tuesday, June 4, 2019

Immediately following the Graduation Ceremony

## BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

The WLHS Substance-Free Grad Party 2019 is organized and chaperoned by parent volunteers. It is NOT a WLHS sponsored function. To ensure the success of this annual event, the following behavior will need to be followed.

1. This is a substance-free event. This means NO alcoholic beverages or drugs will be tolerated.
2. This event is ONLY open to WLHS Seniors.
3. To ensure the success of this event and our student's safety, the location of this event is TOP SECRET.
4. Seniors are REQUIRED to ride the buses to and from the event. Buses will depart from the Chiles Center approximately directly following the graduation ceremony. Students will be returned to the WLHS at approximately 5:00AM on Wednesday June 5th. For safety; students should NOT drive themselves home. Parents will be expected to pick up students at the high school @ 5:00AM.
5. Seniors will be REQUIRED to remain at the party's venue throughout the ENTIRE event.
6. Any inappropriate, disrespectful behavior, profanity, indecent exposure, violence, threats of violence, damage to property, injury to self or others, or use of alcohol and drugs will NOT be tolerated. If this does occur, parent will be contacted, regardless of the time, and will need to pick up their child.
7. Attire: casual (change out of your dressy graduation clothes before you board the buses, give to parents). This is an indoor/outdoor event, so a sweatshirt will be allowed. Swimming is an option so bring a swimsuit. Towels will be provided, as well as hair dryers, and hair products.
8. NOTE: Registered seniors will be given a bag when they pick up their cap & gown. This bag for swim suit and feminine products ONLY. There will also be a small bag for necessary medications listed on Medical Form. All bags and medicines will be turned in to the volunteers when the student picks up their wristband, the morning of rehearsal and will be returned to students on the bus so that they can change into bathing suits as soon as they arrive at the venue. Medication will be held by a medical professional throughout the evening. (Please note: the bags will be checked)
9. NOT ALLOWED: Cell phones, cameras, electronics of any kind, purses, valuables, towels, hair dryers, hair products, cap and gown, extra clothes, etc. There will NOT be a secure area to store anything of value. All items not allowed will be confiscated immediately, so empty all pockets.
10. NOTE: Wristbands, proof of Grad Party registration, will be attached on students' wrists during the morning of the Graduation Rehearsal. It is IMPERATIVE that they wear this band all day. ONLY students with wristbands will be allowed onto the buses for the Grad Party.
11. NOTE: All chaperones will have cell phones. If students need to contact parents during the event, it can be done.
